Dear Parishioners,

The Kingdom of God is at hand!! What beautiful words we hear from Jesus today in the Gospel. These are words of encouragement and words of promise. I grew up in Delaware and moved to Los Angeles close to 20 years ago looking for adventure. Little did I know at the time that God was calling me to the priesthood and had the adventure of a lifetime in store for me! Once I entered the seminary, I called the San Fernando Valley home and would frequently come to the Eucharistic Chapel here at SJE to pray. I could feel my heart burning with love for God and it is that love for God which continues to burn in my heart and seeks to find His burning presence alive in others. They are a very loving community who offered me the opportunity to continue growing in wisdom and grace.

The prophet is encouraging the people who were mourning to rejoice because God promises to spread His prosperity over them like a river and to comfort them like a mother comforts her child. May these words be a promise to us all who may at one time, or another feel like we are returning from a dark time and are looking for our way forward; for those times

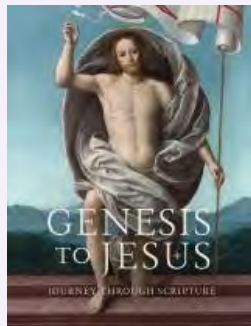
