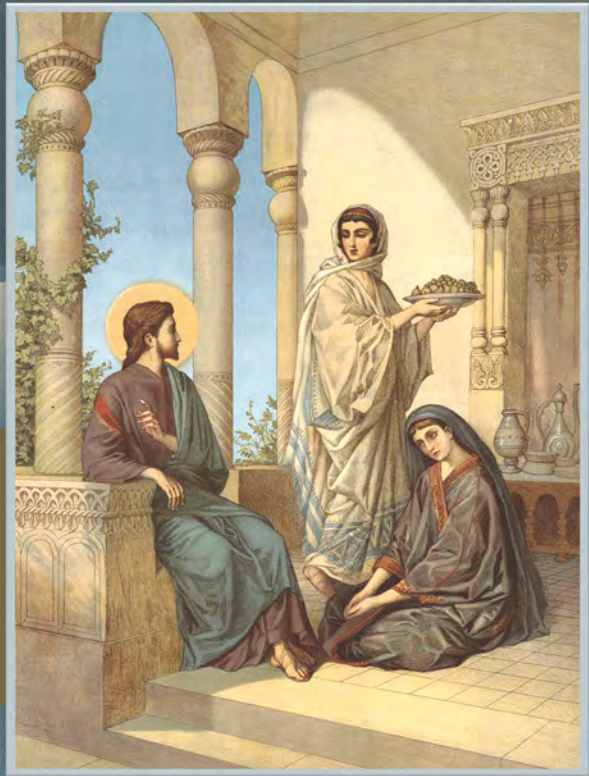

There is need of only one thing. These are the words that Jesus speaks to Martha in the Gospel this weekend. He speaks these words to her when she is getting anxious and worried about all of the things that must be done. Jesus listens to and encourages Martha, as well as all of us, to lay down her burdens and to rest with him awhile. He is not telling her, or us, to avoid our responsibilities or abandon our duties, but rather to complete our tasks with a spirit of peace and trust that God is with us. There is time for our responsibilities, but in a loving way.

As I begin my time as administrator here at St. John Eudes parish, I am encouraged by this message, because it reminds me of what is truly important; union with God. There are so many little things to do to be brought up to speed as administrator; setting up my voicemail, making sure I have all of the correct keys and going over the parish and school finances in addition to countless other tasks. But if my focus becomes task oriented rather than love oriented, then I'm afraid I have missed the mark. I will then have become more concerned with performance rather than loving presence.

This is a temptation that has the potential to creep up on all of us from time to time. We may feel so drawn to the doing that we miss the tender moment and then become resentful with others because they aren't helping us in the way that we think they should assist with our duties. I'm thinking now of married couples and how they raise the family or coworkers who share responsibility on a project at work. There is a difference between anxiety, laziness and grace. Jesus is inviting us to rest with him, receive his grace and to live our lives in union with him. I imagine that if Martha actually did rest with Jesus and received the one thing necessary, his love, then the three of them would have gone back into the kitchen peacefully to finish preparing the meal together.

A friend of mine who spends time working at Urban Sanctuary, a safe space in Hollywood where those living on the streets can rest for a while, recently shared a story about how God has been slowly but surely, revealing his transformative love through "a guest" who frequents that sanctuary space. She shared that upon first coming to Urban Sanctuary, this guest would struggle with relating with others and yell frequently. The guest would return to the sanctuary often, speaking insults that were received with a listening heart, always with hospitality, and was offered a place to sit and sleep in quiet. The guest is now able to make eye contact, smile, engage in conversation, and express gratitude for experiencing God's peace.

That is the power of God's enduring love. He can change us. This person is becoming more of who God made them to be and is offering us an example and witness of how to receive and rest in God's transforming love.

May we all rest with Jesus and be who he made us to be.

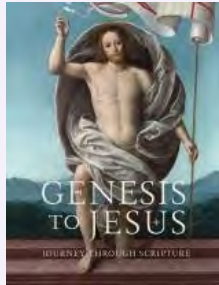

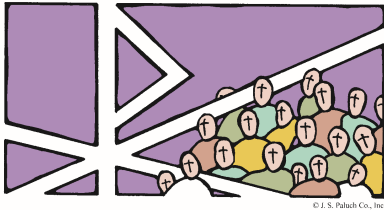

Did you Know?



Plan ahead for safe, fun
summer trips . . .

Amusement parks are great places to make memories as a family, but it's important to plan ahead to maximize fun and keep everyone safe. Go over the family rules in advance, and refresh information on the way there. Make sure that everyone follows the buddy system, with at least two people together at all times. Pick a predetermined meet-up site in the event of separations, and show children where they can go for help (information desk, park security).
