“LORD TEACH US HOW TO PRAY.”

In the Gospel today, the disciples ask Jesus about prayer. They had observed him in prayer and seen the strength that he drew from his prayer and they yearned to be drawn into that type of prayer. Prayer for Jesus was about entering into communion with His Heavenly Father. This communion was not an isolated event, a one time spoken word, but rather it was a way of living a holy space of mystical communion with His Father and with others.

In the prayer that Jesus shared, the Lord's Prayer, Jesus prays, “Father, hallowed be your name.” He is giving honor and respect to His Father and teaching us to do so as well. Holy is your name. The very next words are “Your kingdom come.” This type of prayer is not about getting our way and what we want, but rather, allowing God's own will and His own kingdom to break upon us and into our world. We are being drawn into the mystical reality of God, rather than drawing God into our own supposed reality.

This type of prayer enables us to get in touch with and open up to the areas within ourselves that are not yet perfect. Awareness of our own brokenness and imperfections allows us to relate with others in their own struggles; “forgive us our sins, for we ourselves forgive everyone in debt to us.”

I had a recent conversation with a friend who shared about how he has recently been spending a lot of time in still and quiet prayer. In this prayer he began getting in touch with that deep inner world alive within himself. He revealed that many delicate, tender and significant moments in his life began surfacing. He felt that these memories were coming up because of this type of still prayer. He said, “All of those memories were available to me - I didn't have to think to navigate through them, they were just there. I had been cultivating a practice of sitting in that still space and letting go. When the memories started surfacing, I wanted to ask what was happening and why it was happening but I knew that it was God's business and I didn't have to figure it out.”

This type of prayerful communion with the Father was supporting him and enabling him to trust and to go into his vulnerable memories. His inner life was being recalibrated according to the ways of the Heavenly Father; ways of tender mercy and assuring love. We don't need to know what the Father is doing but we just keep praying “your will be done on earth as it is in heaven.”

In another place, Jesus instructs his disciples to “seek first the kingdom of heaven and its righteousness and all these other things will be given you besides.” In the Gospel just last week, Jesus shared that only “one thing is necessary.” This one thing necessary, communion

With the Father, comes alive within our hearts and burns with the very intimate presence of Christ as we spend time with God in prayer.

This week may we continue to rest with the Lord and pray that His Kingdom come.

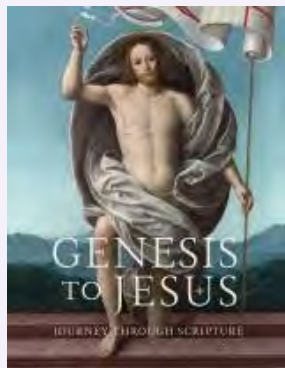
