**“Where your treasure is,  
there also will your heart be.”**

There are many places where we can find our treasures. We may find our treasure in the material things of this world - gold, a new cell phone or a fancy car; we can treasure the experiences of this world - beautiful dinners, an afternoon walk in the park, a child’s laughter; we can find our treasure in the relationships of our world - our family, friends and community; and we can also find our treasure in the spiritual things of this world - generosity, forgiveness and love.

Jesus reminds us that where ever we find our treasure, we will also find our hearts. By using the word heart, He is referring to the central part of ourselves or what we find most important; our heart is what we value most in life. What ever we value most in life we will work toward and spend the majority of our time and energy focusing on it. If we value accumulating money, we will work for a bigger bank account; if we value a child’s laughter, we will slow down to find joy in the simple things of life; if we value our relationships, we will spend quality time with those that we care for; and if we value the spiritual things of this world, we will spend our time loving others.

In his book, Treasure Island, Robert Louis Stevenson tells the tale of Jim Hawkins, an innkeepers son, who joins Captain Smollett along with his crew as they use a treasure map in hopes of finding the infamous pirate Captain Flint’s buried treasure. Hawkins and the others were searching for adventure as much as they were hoping to discover material riches. They encountered danger, betrayal and certain death in their quest for gold. While they eventually return back to port with their booty, Hawkins vows to never undertake another voyage to the island.

Jesus, came to earth and encountered danger, betrayal and certain death in search for His treasure, our hearts. He yearned, and still longs to be the center of our lives. He wants to be our treasure and He leaves us the Gospel as our treasure map. When we see Him on the Cross, we have found where our treasure is buried, for X marks the spot.

The Cross truly represents what is most valuable in life; love. This love of Jesus, a divine love, is not simply an emotion or something that feels good. Rather, this love is a sacrifice, it’s a choice and it’s an act of the will. On our own we cannot love that much. But with God’s own love we can respond to Him in love. So, “do not be afraid any longer, little flock, for your Father is pleased to give you the kingdom.” The kingdom of God is our treasure - the kingdom of God is our inheritance.

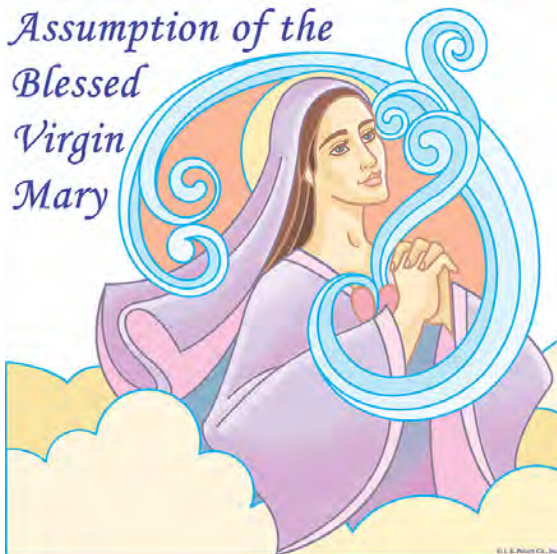

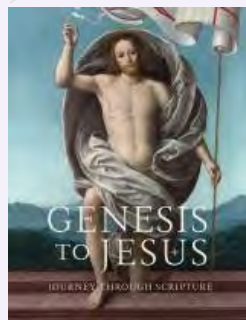

**Using vanishing communication technology to send harmful messages . . .**

From your cell phone you can send virtually any form of communication — even messages that disappear almost immediately after being sent. With apps like Snapchat and Instagram, or even some texting apps, children with social media accounts can communicate privately and secretly, sending messages and pictures that disappear after they are seen. Obviously, vanishing messages pose a problem, as parents can't monitor what their children are saying or receiving. Check your child's phone for these apps and talk about the importance of transparency and honesty.
