### “I Will Look After and Tend My Sheep.” (Ez 34:11)

This weekend our parish celebrates the Feast of St. John Eudes! While his feast day is officially August 19<sup>th</sup>, we are celebrating our patron saint in a special way at both the 11:00 am Mass and 2:15 pm Mass this Sunday. We are presenting service awards and certificates of appreciation to those volunteers who have served our parish, school and community with their time, talent and treasure for many years. In particular, we are honoring Rick Crandall, Ernie Star and Florence Guest for the many contributions that they have made and the life that they have brought to this parish community. Thank You!! We also recognize and appreciate the many ministers who volunteer their time serving our parish as sacristans; we thank you for always helping us to prepare to celebrate Mass and to enter a place of prayer.

In the first reading for this Solemnity, the prophet Ezekiel speaks the heart of God when he says, “I will look after and tend my sheep.” (Ez 34:11) These words remind us of how special and loved we are by God. He will look after and tend to us. He continues by saying, “As a shepherd tends his flock when he finds himself among his scattered sheep, so will I tend my sheep.” (Ez 34:12) We are presented with the image of a shepherd who knows his sheep even when they are scattered and dispersed; a God who continues to guide and care for us even during difficult times. St. John Eudes certainly was a priest after the heart of God. He was someone who cared for those sheep who had been scattered and those who were struggling. During a severe time of plagues, St. John Eudes went to care for the sick; even to the point of having to separate himself from others in his own religious community for fear of making them sick. Eudes took on the infirmities of others as his own; he became one with them in their suffering. In addition to the physically sick, Eudes also began to care for the vulnerable women who found themselves caught up in the trappings of prostitution. He opened a house for them, gave them shelter and helped to care for their souls. The first reading concludes with the promise, “The lost I will seek out, the strayed I will bring back, the injured I will bind up, the sick I will heal, shepherding them rightly.” (Ez 34:16)

So often, it seems, that our world today has lost its way. There are continuous reports of violence erupting in places formerly thought of as being safe; tensions and divisions surfacing between politicians and even religious leaders; and fear, anger and distrust being fomented between neighbors and peoples of different colors, ethnic backgrounds and religious beliefs. All these tensions and anxieties weigh on us physically, emotionally and spiritually. We may even begin to feel sick or depressed without knowing why. Amid these difficult times, God promises to be our shepherd and to send good shepherds to lead us and

guide us to safe pastures; “beside restful waters he leads me; he refreshes my soul.” (Ps 23:2-3) St. John Eudes was one of those good shepherds. He was regarded as an excellent preacher and confessor and he brought about a great spiritual renewal to parishes through the missions that he led and to the priesthood through the seminaries that he founded. His spirit continues to live on here at our parish. We find those restful waters when we come here to pray and to be refreshed; we find renewal through the many prayer groups and ministries offered here at our parish; and we find good shepherding and examples of Christ in the leaders that we honor today. Rick, Ernie and Florence, we thank you for being people after the heart of Jesus and we thank you for serving this community so well.

May God bless you this week, through the intercession of St. John Eudes and Our Blessed Mother and may He always keep you in His Sacred Heart,

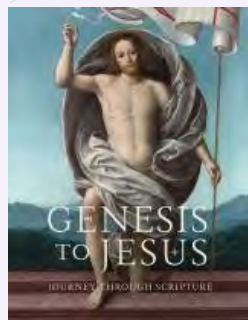

la celebración de la Santa Misa como en entrar en un espíritu de oración.

En la primera lectura de esta solemnidad, el profeta Ezequiel habla del corazón de Dios cuando dice: "Cuidaré y veré por mis ovejas" (Ez 34:11). Estas palabras nos recuerdan cuán especiales y amados somos por Dios... Él vera y cuidara de nosotros. Continúa diciendo: "Como un pastor cuida a su rebaño cuando se encuentra entre sus ovejas dispersas, así cuidaré a mis ovejas" (Ez 34:12). Se nos presenta la imagen de un pastor que conoce a sus ovejas incluso cuando están lejos y dispersos del redil; un Dios que continúa guiándonos y cuidándonos incluso en tiempos difíciles. San Juan Eudes ciertamente fue un sacerdote según el corazón de Dios. Era alguien que se preocupaba por las ovejas que estaban lejos del redil y las que estaban luchando. Durante un tiempo severo de plagas, San Juan Eudes fue a cuidar a los enfermos; incluso hasta el punto de tener que separarse de los demás en su propia comunidad religiosa por temor a enfermarlos. Eudes asumió las enfermedades de los demás como suyas; se hizo uno con ellos en su sufrimiento. Además de los enfermos físicos, Eudes también cuidó a las mujeres vulnerables que se vieron atrapadas en las trampas de la prostitución. Les abrió una casa, les dio refugio y les ayudó a sanar sus almas. La primera lectura concluye con la promesa: " Yo buscaré la perdida, y haré volver al redil la descarriada; vendaré la perniquebrada, y fortaleceré la débil; más a la engordada y a la fuerte destruiré; las apacentaré con justicia" (Ez 34:16).

Con tanta frecuencia, parece, que nuestro mundo de hoy ha perdido el rumbo. Hay informes continuos de violencia en lugares que antes se consideraban seguros; tensiones y divisiones surgiendo entre políticos e incluso líderes religiosos; y se fomenta el miedo, la ira y la desconfianza entre vecinos y pueblos de diferentes colores, razas y creencias religiosas. Todas estas tensiones y ansiedades nos pesan psíquica, emocional y espiritualmente. Incluso podemos comenzar a sentirnos enfermos o deprimidos sin saber por qué. En estos tiempos difíciles, Dios promete ser nuestro pastor y nos envía buenos pastores para pastorearnos y guiarnos hacia pastos seguros; "En lugares de delicados pastos me hará descansar; Junto a aguas de reposo me pastoreará" (Salmo 23: 2-3) San Juan Eudes fue uno de esos buenos pastores. Fue considerado como un excelente predicador y confesor y hizo una gran renovación espiritual en las parroquias por medio de las misiones que dirigió y ayudo con el sacerdocio por medio de los seminarios que fundó. El espíritu de él sigue viviendo aquí en nuestra parroquia. Encontramos esas aguas tranquilas cuando entramos aquí ya sea para rezar o para refrescarnos; encontramos renovación con los muchos grupos de oración y ministerios que tenemos aquí en nuestra parroquia; y encontramos buenos pastores y ejemplos de Cristo en los líderes que honramos hoy. Rick, Ernie y Florence, te agradecemos por ser personas que siguen el corazón de Jesús y te agradecemos por servir a nuestra comunidad.

### Don't let a predator use fear to manipulate a child . . .

Many victims of abuse don't report the abuse right away, if ever. Predators groom their victims, and part of this process is designed to make the victim feel like they should trust their predator, even more so than their own parents. Many victims also have a fear that their parents or trusted adults won't believe them, or that they will get in trouble for what happened — sometimes an abuser will threaten a child, using the child's fear to buy the child's silence. It's important for parents to teach their children to talk with their parents about what is happening to them, what might be frightening them, and that they will be supported in disclosing.
