Why Does Jesus Teach in Parables?

Have you ever wondered what's up with all of the parables? Why doesn't Jesus speak in plain language? We have been hearing a lot of parables at mass of late. They are an important form of teaching that can help an open hearted Christian reencounter the living Lord.

Parables are a kind of story that can teach us Truth, not just facts. The first bible study I ever attended was facilitated by a biblical professor from DePaul University in Chicago. As she held up a bible, the first words she spoke were; "Everything in this bible is True, and some of actually happened." The same is true of parables. They convey Truth independently of whether or not the stories factually happened or not.

Plain facts about Jesus can sometimes be misleading information when seeking a deeper or first encounter with the living Lord. In the spiritual life, there is an expression that I find helpful sometimes... "sometimes the good can be the enemy of the best." We have to look further than just the facts. I would even say that it might be best to not start a search with facts. Facts are good, but they often lead to the trap of constantly seeking to "prove" God's existence. God does not need proof of existence any more than do you or I.

In the Gospel of John, Jesus says to Thomas, "Have you come to believe because you have seen me? Blessed are those who have not seen and have believed." Seeing is "OK" but belief without seeing is best. Belief before seeing is a truly Catholic and "sacramental" way of encountering the living Lord and it is why Jesus uses parables. If someone is trying to convince you to believe based on seeing evidence, RUN!! Think of St. Paul in his first encounter with the risen Lord, no science there. So, parables are Truth and some of them, may or may not have happened.

Pay attention to your surroundings to prevent child abuse . . .

As a caring adult, you scope out potential dangers in the areas where a child may be for school, birthday parties, playdates, outings with friends, etc.

Another danger to add to your list is the potential for a child to be lured away into a private area by a predator. Abuse can happen anywhere, even in the most public of places, and parents should be aware of any secluded spots that a predator might use. Avoid spaces where a predator could take action – turn on lights, check empty rooms, and patrol sleeping or playing spaces.
